How to incorporate HFOSS in education

- 1. Get involved with <u>POSSE</u> or the <u>Teaching Open Source Community</u>
- 2. Do research using open source software
- 3. Introduce Linux module into Intro CS classes
- 4. Introduce concepts of free software and open source software
 - 1. Pirates of the Silicon Valley (movie and documentary)
 - 2. Revolution OS
 - 3. Read "The Cathedral and the Bazaar"
- 5. Do open source scavenger hunt
- 6. Have students try to fix a bug
- 7. Have students document open source code
- 8. Use a git repository system to turn in programming assignments (Bitbucket or GitHub)
- 9. Create an open source project
- 10. Create a course named Introduction to Open Source






