Eligibility Requirements

- **To be eligible for a scholarship, you must :**
 - Be accepted for enrollment as a full-time graduate student for the 2008-2009 academic years at a UPR graduate school.
 - Applicants must submit copy of acceptance letter from UPR
 - Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00.
 - Applicants must submit GPA Certification/transcript
 - Qualify for Financial Aid
 - Financial need will be determined by the UPR financial aid office and/or the UPRAA Scholarship committee.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on:

- Academic record
- Financial need
- Written Recommendations
- Essay response
- Interview

Application Preparation

Use the official application form or a photocopy of the form. Use a computer or typewriter to complete your form. Applications that are illegible will be disqualified.

- Answer all questions.
- Submit Financial Aid documents to the Financial Aid office
- **Submit the documents listed below**
 - Official Application Form
 - Transcripts
 - Transcripts should include GPA
 - Essay

- Letters of recommendation
 - Two letters of recommendation (in English or Spanish).
 - An instructor or advisor must complete letters.
 - A relative **MAY NOT** complete letters.

Application Deadlines

All materials must be submitted as one package for receipt on or before May 30, 2008

Interviews

The UPRAA Scholarship Committee will interview finalists. Interviews may be conducted at the University of Puerto Rico (campus to be determined), or via teleconference. Interviews will be conducted in July.

Award

- The scholarship will be awarded for one year.
- The award is to be used to cover tuition expenses.
- The UPRAA Scholarship Fund will award a student up to a maximum of \$4,000 per academic year to **cover tuition cost** (as defined by UPR).
- Awardee must remain in good standing throughout the academic year.
- Actual award amounts will be finalized between the UPRAA scholarship committee and the UPR financial aid office based on tuition cost on any given year.
 - Payment of up to \$4,000 will be applied toward the 2008-2009 school year (August 2007 through May 2008) and will be paid to the UPR.
 - Any unused funds must be returned to the Dr. Manuel A. Febo Scholarship Fund

Award Notification

Awardee will be notified by the last week of July. Awardees may be notified via e-mail and/or telephone; therefore, it is extremely important that applicants provide the e-mail address and telephone numbers on the application form.
